Accessibility In Pittsfield Parks

The city of Pittsfield wants to learn more about the barriers people with disabilities experience when utilizing city parks and outdoor spaces.

A person with a disability is someone who experiences, or experienced, a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activity. Typical barriers that make it more challenging for people with disabilities include broken curb ramps, steep pedestrian pathways, cracked sidewalks, lack of maneuverability for wheelchairs, playgrounds without transfer systems, signs that are difficult to read or understand, and lack of accessible parking.
