
Men's Group:

Health

- I have the right to know about my health and what could be dangerous to my health.
- I have the right to choose the healthcare providers I want involved in my care.
 - I have the right to refuse unnecessary medical treatments, medications, and care.
 - I have the right to receive the treatment to meet all my health needs.

What I am responsible for with that Right:

I have the responsibility to educate myself on medications and treatment and their possible side effects before choosing to participate in them.
